- REMINDER: Please make sure that your trash cans are not in the street on trash day. They should be ON the curb not in front of it.



We meet as needed to discuss the "state of the landscape" and bounce around ways to enhance our beautiful neighborhood. The project that was completed in June was an extensive project to replace dead trees and bushes, grind stumps that have been around a long time and basically try to get things looking as good as possible with the limited budget we currently work under. You will notice the clubhouse entrance and sides have been completely redesigned to have some interest year-round from both the road and the clubhouse. The skinny medians along Lake View have also been redesigned. The red yuccas have been relocated to a new end cap on Prairie View at Marcus and purple wintercreeper has been put in its place. We continue to work on getting signage at the 67 entrance of Lakeridge with a new concept being considered. If we can get city approval, we hope to match the entrance at the front only on a much smaller scale of course. Some of the muhly grass at the Prairie View entrance took a hit with the 2 cold winters. Gladys Stigger, Judy Hatch, and Kay Davidson met with Lawns of Dallas to discuss replacements. We formulated a great plan and are waiting on a bid from Lawns of Dallas and an approval from the board to move forward with that. Anyone interested in joining the committee is certainly welcome. New ideas are always welcomed and encouraged so feel free to reach out to any committee member with ideas and suggestions. We also encourage you to reach out when you see things in need of repair. We try to stay on top of it, but the more eyes, the better. Let's all continue to enjoy the beauty of this little hidden gem.



The Social Committee


